Record of tithing donations and "offerings for the poor" received by Jacob G. Bigler, bishop of the Kanesville Branch, and Aaron Johnson, presiding bishop of Pottawattamie County, Iowa, October 1849-January 1852. Includes information about distributions to the poor of Kanesville and vicinity and an account of labor and materials donated toward the construction of the Log Tabernacle, 1849-1850. Also contains a brief section entitled "Bishops Docket," which reports ecclesiastical court cases brought before Bishop William W. Lane and his counselors, Jacob G. Bigler and Lorenzo Johnson, 1850-1851.

1 \$ fractions in oz. half and 3/4 not clearly marked. Use the total value divided by quantity to see the true unit price in ¢. This is especially true of the meat and cheese. They are not valuing 150 lbs of meat at 3-5¢, or 18 lbs of cheese for \$8 with 2 3/4 bunch of onions at \$50 a unit. Beef is worth 9¢ a pound in 1860.
