Voted that a meeting be held in each

ward next sunday attend by one of the

counselors to lay the case before the brethren

and endeavor to stimulate them to

action

After some spirited remarks from bro's

Smith & Harris.. Voted that all who go 1st this

fall with teams to assist the poor be instructed

to meet at Keg Creek Bridge on Wednesday
evening

next in redness to proceed on their journey

Voted that Jno.Murdock take the oversight

of all teams and men who go from the

East side of the Mo. River and appoint others

as he shall deem best,, bro's Smith & Harris

requested a report to be sent to the Twelve of

all teams wagons &c sent from this side of

the river adjourned till Oct. 10th --A. M.
