Cols C. M. Johnson was then appointed to order a scout against the Indians and inteligence was ordered to be circulated to the different Branches, to form their companies, appoint their Captains and come to the Indian Mill on Monday next with two days provisons and forty rounds of catarage.. On J. M. Benson's recommend Joshua Hall was appointed to raise a company above Pigeon opperate in concert with the other companies.. Remarks by several counselors, Bro. Geo. W. Harris presented himself before the council requesting their aid in getting him a house to live in. A motion was made and seconded that a subscription be drawn and circulated,, carried..

Adjourned 1 week at 1 P. M.
